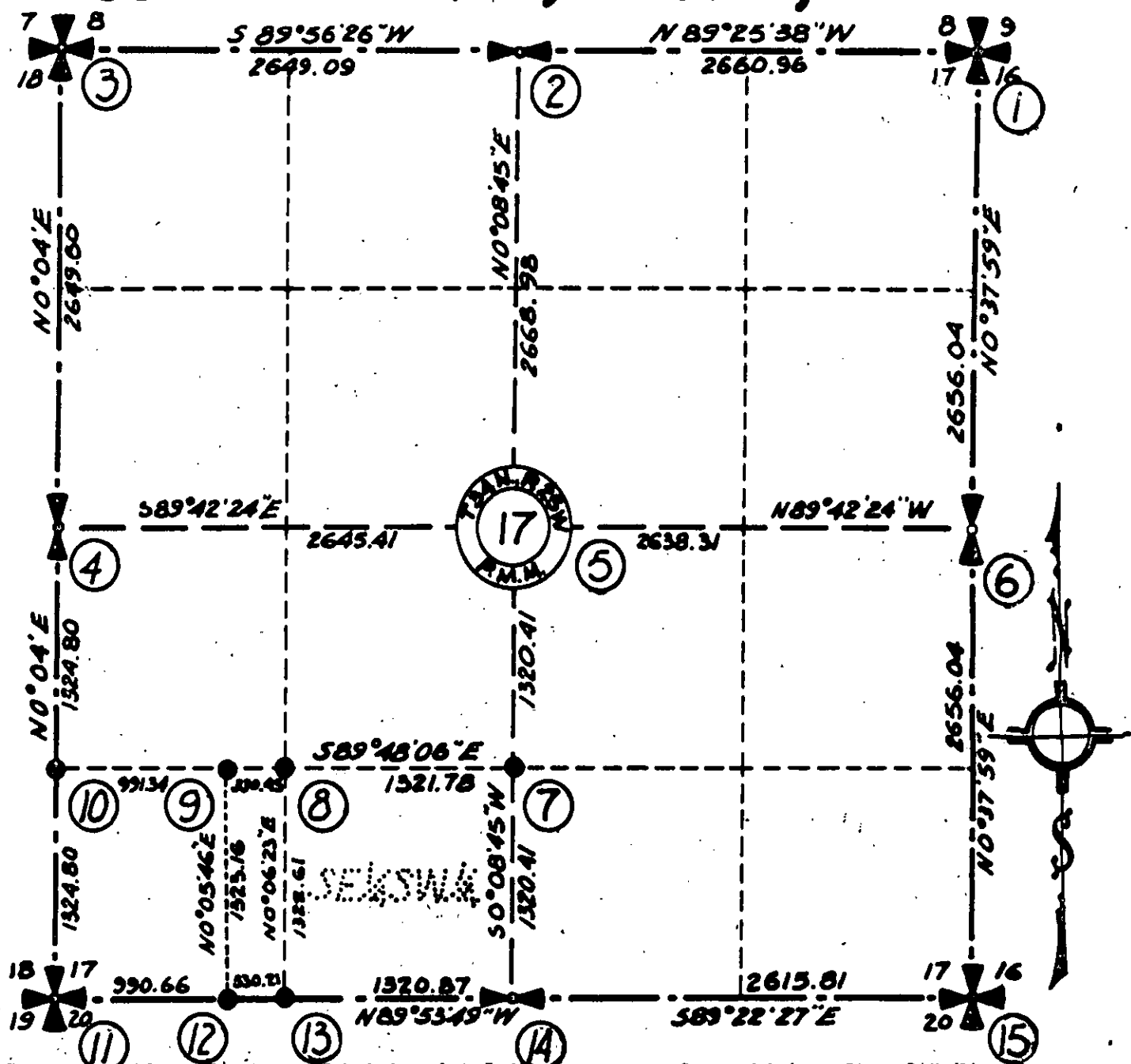

- (1) NE Cor. Sec. 17 T. 34 N., R. 25 W found B.L.M. Brass cap from which a Fir, 21" dia. bears N $45\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E 39 lks. A Fir 14" dia. bears S $23\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E 38 lks. A Fir 16" dia. bears S 57° W 74 lks. A Fir 21" dia. bears N $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 59 lks.
- (2) North $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. Sec. 17 T 34 N., R. 25 W found B.L.M. Brass cap with 4 B.T.S.
- (3) NW Cor. Sec. 17 T 34 N., R. 25 W found B.L.M. Brass cap with 3 B.T.S.
