80:00 Set a limestone 12x10x8 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs.21,22,27 & 28 marked with 2 notches on S & 3 notches on E. edges - from which a tamarack 12 ins. diam. bears N.40° 45'E. 19 lks. dist. marked T.34 N. R.25 W.S 22 B.T. a fir 6 ins. diam. bears S. 10°30'E. 25 lks. dist. marked T.34 N. R. 25 W.S. 27 B.T. a fir 6 ins. diam. bears S. 24° 45'W. 17 lks. dist. marked T.34 N. R. 25 W.S. 28 B.T. a pine 8 ins. diam. bears N. 8°30' W. 41 lks. dist. marked T. 34N. R.25 W.S. 21 B.T.

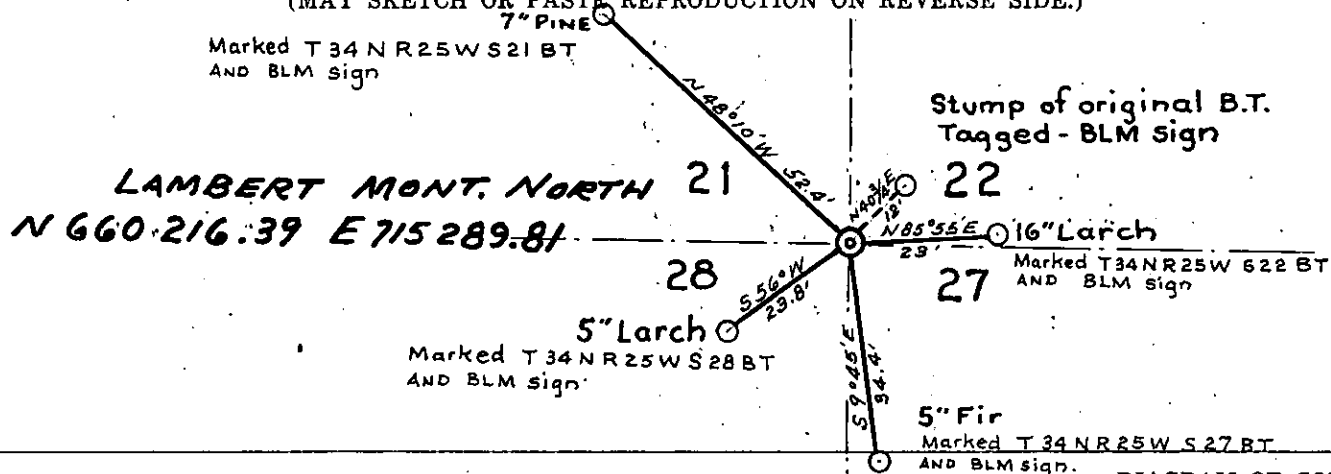
Set a Std. brass U.S. F.S. tablet in concrete with large stone around pipe.

Original stone on top of mound all new bearing trees tagged with Std.BLM bearing tree signs. Corner is in South East corner of small natural clearing about 100 feet South of rocky clearing overlooking valley to North

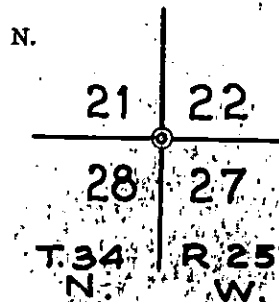

Position confirmed by all BTs F.S. location poster on 16" larch marked 15 feet west to corner.

Actually original stone is S 78°30'W. 23 feet from this tree

Except the larch the remaining 3 original bearing trees are too rotted to tag.

SW Bearing tree-6" fir found blown down partially burned - partly positively legible

SE Bearing tree - 6" fir found - blown down, partially burned - blaze positive but marking illegible

NW Bearing tree - 8" pine - found blown down, badly burned and rotted but position checks report

NE Bearing tree 12" larch - only partially burned stump found but position checks reported (tagged this-BIM Tag)
