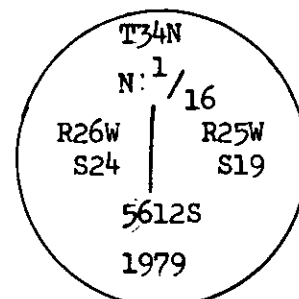
Set a 3 x 30" aluminum pipe approx. 24" in ground with alum. cap marked:

A 15" spruce bears N14°48'E 32.6ft., scribed N1/16 S19BT.

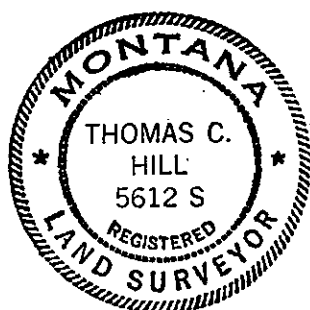
Place N.F. Property Boundary post and ATTENTION sign at

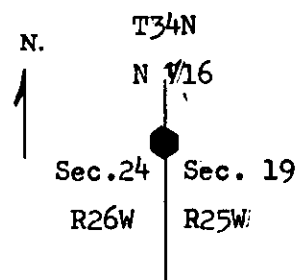

The ninth part of the report deals with the judicial situation, which is characterized by a lack of independence and impartiality. The tenth part of the report discusses the overall situation of the country, which is one of stagnation and decline.
