
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

- I. No previous history.
- II. No evidence found.
- III. At the corner position as determined by survey, set a 30 in. long, 3/4 in. diam. alum. rod, 27 ins. in the ground, in a small collar of stone, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. alum. cap, mkd. as shown:




Established two bearing trees:

A larch, 23 ins. diam., bears S55°W, 27.8 ft. dist., scribed "C-E-W-E 1/256 BT". A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N25°W, 45.2 ft. dist., scribed "C-E-W-E 1/256 BT".


Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. steel guard post, South, 2.0 ft., with Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary decals.
