

I. 1981 Certified Corner Recordation by John H. Ninneman, Book 1, page 1021: Set a 5/8 in. x 24 in. capped steel pin stamped "J.H.N. 4661S".

from which:

A fence post bears East, 6.1 ft. dist., with a location poster.

- II. Found a 5/8 in. diam. rebar.
- III. As determined by survey, I accept the position of the found rebar and set a 30 in. long, 3/4 in. diam. alum. rod, alongside of rebar, with 3 1/4 in. alum. cap, mkd. as shown:



Established two bearing trees:

A spruce, 4 ins. diam., bears N24°E, 22.7 ft. dist., scribed "X BT". A spruce, 7 ins. diam., bears S2°E, 11.2 ft. dist., scribed "CS 1/16 S17 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. steel guard post, South, 3.0 ft., with Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary decals.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
