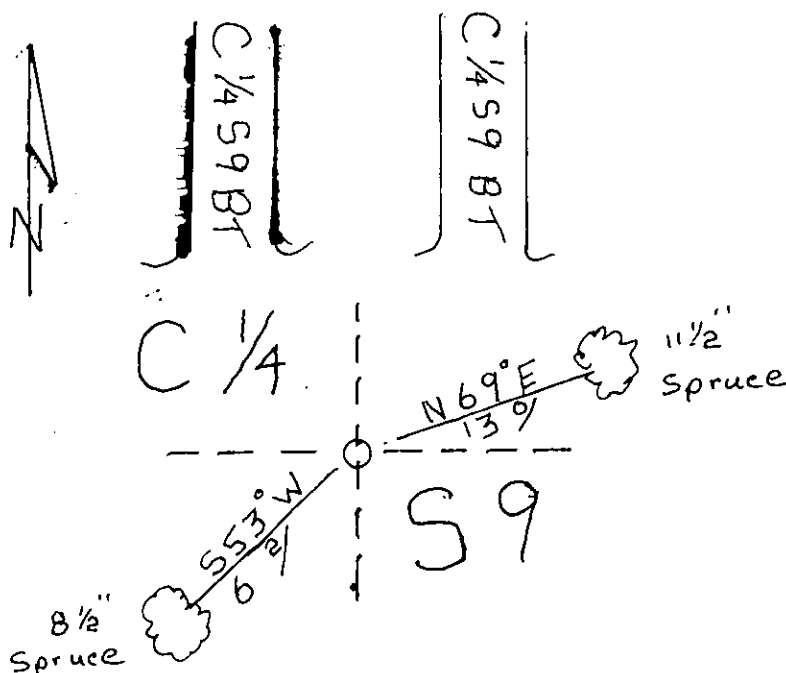

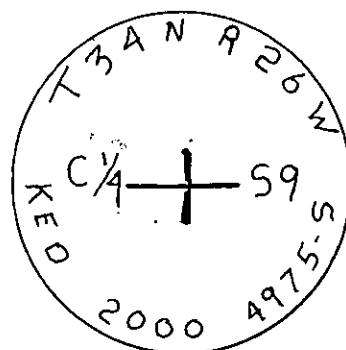
A 8 1/2 inch DBH spruce which bears S 53° W, 6.2 feet dist. scribed C 1/4 S 9 BT.
