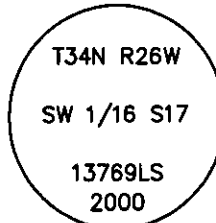


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner SW1/16 Sec. 17 T. 34 N. R. 26 W. P.M.M. LINCOLN County

- I. Record: No previous record.
- II. No evidence found.
- III. At the position determined by survey, set a 3/4 in. diam. aluminum rod, 30 ins. long, 27 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap marked as shown:

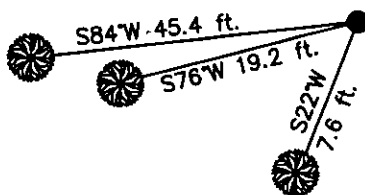


The new bearing trees:

A larch, 8 ins. diam., bears S22°W, 7.6 ft. dist., marked SW 1/16 S17 BT.
 A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears S84°W, 45.4 ft. dist., marked "X" BT.
 Location poster on a larch, 5 ins. diam., bears S76°W, 19.2 ft. dist.

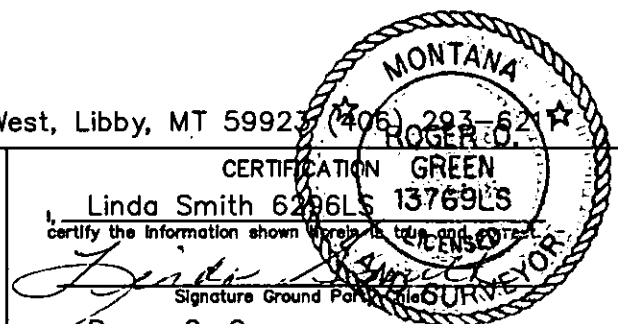
Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post 3.0 ft. west and south, with Property Boundary and Land Survey Monument decals attached. Attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs to the bearing trees. Attached brass disc directly above scribed "B" on both bearing trees. Disc reads LS 13769. Painted red bands around the bearing trees.

NOT TO SCALE

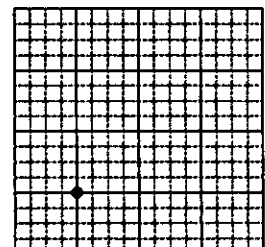
