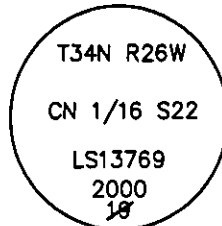


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner CN1/16 Sec. 22 T 34 N. R. 26 W. P.M.M. LINCOLN County

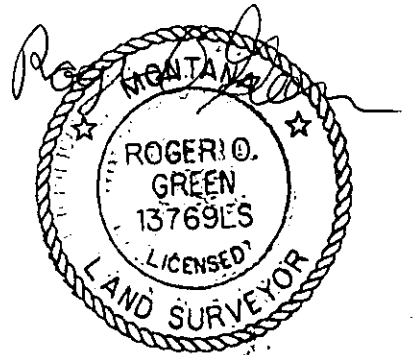
- I. Record: No previous record.
- II. No evidence found.
- III. At the position determined by survey, set a 3/4 in. diam. aluminum rod, 48 ins. long, 43 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap marked as shown:



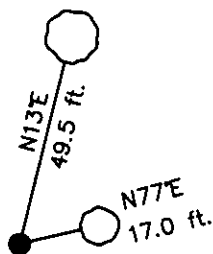
The new bearing trees:

- A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N13°E, 49.5 ft. dist., marked CN 1/16 S22 BT.
- A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N77°E, 17.0 ft. dist., marked CN 1/16 S22 BT.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post 2.9 ft. north and 2.5 ft. east, with Property Boundary and Land Survey Monument decals attached. Attached Bearing Tree & Land Survey Monument signs to the bearing trees. Attached brass disk between the 2 and the B on both bearing trees, the disk is marked LS 13769. Painted red bands around the bearing trees.

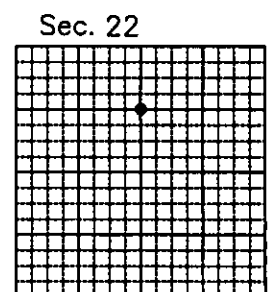


NOT TO SCALE
