 5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
 6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

GLO & BLM Record (GLO Record in parenthesis):

Found limestone 20X10X6 ins., firmly set and mkd. "1/4" on the N. face, and witnessed by the remains of one of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30" long, 2 1/2" diam., 26" in the ground, with brass cap mkd. as shown below, from which:

A stump hole, bears N 34 1/2° W 20 lks, remains of tree lying on ground, mkd. "1/4 SBT" (Record).

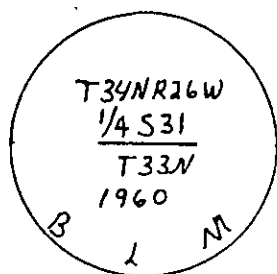
The new bearing trees:

12" Spruce mkd. "1/4 S 31 BT" bears N 83 1/2° E 50 lks

6" larch mkd. "1/4 S 31 BT" bears N 25 3/4° W 62 lks.

Found: BLM Brass cap, as described, from which
12" Tamarack, face overgrown, bears N 25° 44' W 62.
14" Spruce, face overgrown, bears N 83° 25' E 50 lks.

No further monumentation required.

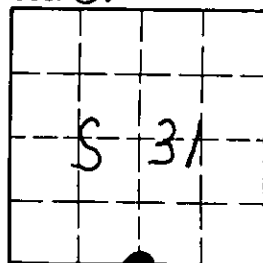
