A 6" fir bears N 33°E, 6 links, marked T 34 N R 25 W S7 BT

A 6" fir bears S 34°E, 46 links, marked T 34 N R 25 W S18 BT

A 8" fir bears S 80°W, 29 links, marked T 34 N R 26 W S13 BT A 10" fir bears N 28°W, 12 links, marked T 34 N R 26 W S 12 BT

2.BLM 1960 - The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, on the W. bdy. of the Tp. monumented with a limestome, 12 x 8 x 6 ins., firmly set and mkd. with 2 grooves on the the N. and 4 grooves on the S faces, and witnessed by the remains of three of the original bearing trees.


