

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found; note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

## CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner Sec. 29, 30, 31 and 32 T. 34N R. 26W P.M.M. LINCOLN County

RECORD: GLO 1895

Set a post 4' long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 29, 30, 31, & 32 marked T34N S 29 on NE; R26W S 32 on SE; S31 on SW and S 30 on NWfaces, with 1 notch on S and 5 notches on E edges; from which

A fir 10" diam. bears N74 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 17 lks. dist. mkd. T34N R26W S29 BT.

A spruce 8" diam. bears S45 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 10 lks. dist. marked T34N R26W S32 BT.

A tamarack 10" diam. bears S15 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 30 lks. dist. marked T34N R26W S31 BT.

A spruce 8" diam. bears N53°W, 12 lks. dist. marked T34N R26W S30 BT.

RECORD: BLM 1960

The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32 monumented with a disintegrated wooden post, firmly set in the ground, and witnessed by the remains of three of the original bearing trees. At the corner point set an iron post 30" long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " diam., 26" in the ground, in concrete, with brass cap from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A dead fir, 10" diam., bears N73°E, 17 lks. dist., mkd. T34N R26W S29 BT. (Record: N74 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 17 lks.)

A stump 12" diam., bears S37 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 10 lks. dist. (Record: S45 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E 10 lks)

A dead larch 12" diam., bears S20 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 30 lks. dist., mkd. with an overgrown blaze. (Record: S15 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 30 lks)

The new bearing trees:

A larch 12" diam., bears N41 3/4°E, 34 lks. dist., mkd. T34N R26W S29 BT.

A larch 10" diam. bears S3°E, 20 lks. dist., mkd. T34N R26W S32 BT.

A larch 11" diam. bears S31 3/4°W, 49 lks. dist., mkd T34N R26W S31 BT.

A cedar 8" diam., bears N73°W, 64 lks. dist., mkd. T34N R26W S30 BT.

## FOUND:

3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " BLM Brass Cap on a Steel Pipe.

N43°E 21.8' 14" tamarack scribing overgrown.

S02°E 13.4' 14" tamarack scribing overgrown.

S31°W 32.8' 13" tamarack scribing overgrown.

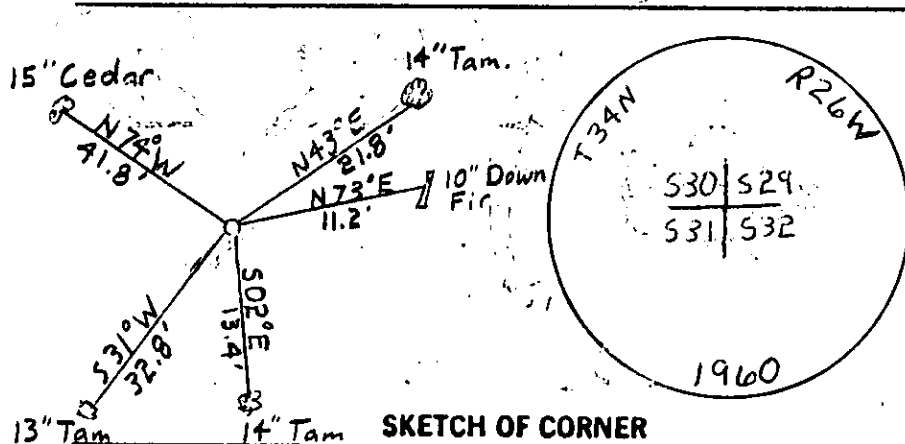
N74°W 41.8' 15" cedar scribing overgrown.

Original 10" down fir N73°E 17 lks (11.22')

Set a 6' Steel Post 3' away from corner.

Maintained bearing trees with sign's and paint.

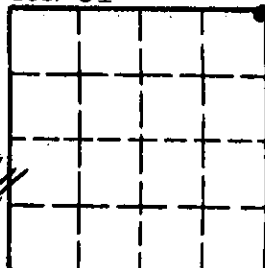
