
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

I. 1894 G.L.O. orig. record by Abram L. Jaqueth: Set a wooden post, and 2 bearing trees.

1961 B.L.M. remonumentation record by David Cunningham: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with a disintegrated wooden post, firmly set in the ground and witnessed by one of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with a brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established two bearing trees.

1983 CCR by Jack Ninneman (4661S): Painted monument and accessories. Established one new bearing tree:

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N34°E, 86.6 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S1 BT".

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, protruding 4 ins. above the ground, mkd. as shown above, from which:

A fir stump, 18 ins. diam., bears N29°E, 18.5 ft.. dist., mkd. with visible scribing. (B.L.M. rec.) A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N43°E, 86.6 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (4661S rec.-N34°E) A fir stump, 17 ins. diam., bears S14°E, 69.3 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (B.L.M. record) A fir stump, 24 ins. diam., bears S9°W, 14.5 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (G.L.O. rec.-S5 1/4°W)

III. Established one new bearing tree:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S55°E, 17.9 ft. dist., scribed "1/4 S12 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
