
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner E 1/16 Sec. 6 & 7 T. 34N R. 26W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1978 Certificate of Survey No. 2099 by Manfred L. Haiges No. 2520S: Set a 30 in. long, 2 in. diam. galvanized pipe, with a 2 in. diam. brass cap mkd. as shown:



II. Found a 2 1/4 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 18 ins. above the ground, firmly set, with a 3 in. diam. brass cap mkd. as shown above.

from which:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S82°E, 31.3 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S33°W, 20.75 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face.

Bearing trees had bearing tree signs attached.


III. The Haiges brass cap was accepted as the E 1/16, based on survey.

Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N10°E, 22.8 ft. dist., mkd. "E1/16 S6 BT". A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S60°E, 21.4 ft. dist., mkd. "E 1/16 S7 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
