
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 1/4 Sec. 7 & 18 T. 34N R. 26W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. <u>1894 G.L.O. orig. record by Frank L. Siger and Abram L. Jaqueth:</u> Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked "1/4" on North face, from which:

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S10°E, 31 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S BT". A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N58°W 10 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S BT".

- II. Found a stump out of the ground with "1/4" visible; it's original position was unable to be determined due to logging activity. No evidence of either the corner post or the other original bearing tree was found.
- III. At the position as determined by survey and single proportion, set an alum. rod, 3/4 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, with a 3 1/4 ins. diam. alum. cap, flush with the ground, mkd:



Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N56°W, 7.5 ft. dist., scribed "1/4 S7 BT". A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S4°E, 8.9 ft. dist., scribed "1/4 S18 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel post, East, 3.0 ft. dist., with Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary decals.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
