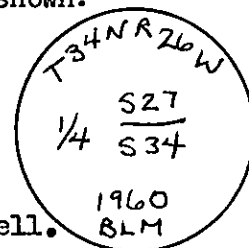

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

1960 B.L.M. record, from found original evidence: Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,
 $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in ground with brass cap marked as shown:
 From which: A 18" larch bears N38°45' W., 32 lks. Scribing visible.
 A 9" fir bears S61° E., 110 lks. Marked: " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 BT."

Found a 2" B.L.M. pipe appr. 7" above ground with brass cap marked as shown:
 Mound of stone appr. 1.5 ft. N. of pipe.

From which: A 15" larch bears N32° E., 21.2 ft. Scribing visible, alive and well.
 A 14" fir bears S59° E., 72.9 ft. Healed face, alive and well.
