No evidence found of stone monument, at a surveyed position, II.

from which:

Rotten remains, bears S04°E, 22.4 ft. dist., "1/4 S13 BT" visible. Rootwad and rotten remains, bears N30°W, 2.6 ft. dist., "S B" visible.

At the corner point, determined by distances-distance intersect from the remains of the original bearing II. trees, set a 30 ins. long aluminum pipe, 2 1/2 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/2 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown.




Established two new bearing trees:
