
Corner 1/4 Sec. 13&24 T. 34N R. 27W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1912 G.L.O. Original Record by William C. Perkins: Set a shale stone, 18x10x6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. "1/4" on the N. face..

Established two bearing trees:

A spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears S22°E, 12 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S24 BT". A spruce, 6 ins. diam., bears N05°W, 8 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S13 BT".

- II. No evidence found of stone monument or the original bearing trees, as the corner position falls in a 1960's logged unit.
- II. At the corner point, set by single proportion, a 30 ins. long aluminum pipe, 2 1/2 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/2 in. diam. aluminum cap, surrounded with a mound of stone, mkd. as shown.



Established two new bearing trees:

A larch, 5 ins. diam., bears N45°E, 9.5 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S13 BT". A larch, 5 ins. diam., bears S63°E, 7.5 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S24 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
