
Rotten remains, bears N78°E, 12.5 ft. dist., possible scribe. (record)

A hole with a down rotten tree, bears S15°E, 17.1 ft. dist., with full visible scribe. (record)

A shallow depression, bears N75°W, 7.2 ft. dist. (record)

At the corner point, center of rotten tree stump, set a 30 ins. long aluminum rod, 3 1/4 in. diam., 26 ins. II. in the ground, with a 3 1/2 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown.



Established four new bearing trees and set a galvanized steel guard post, bears North, 2.0 ft.:


