

- At the corner position, set by single proportion, a 30 ins. long aluminum pipe, 2 1/2 in. diam., 22 ins. in II. the ground, with a 3 1/2 in. diam. aluminum cap, surrounded with a rock collar, mkd. as shown.



Established one new bearing tree:


A 3x3 mound of stone, bears S70°W, 3.8 ft. dist.
