Slatestone 18"x8"x6", 12 in grd. mkd 1/4 on N Face

8" Fir bears N21°E, 19 lks, mkd 1/4 S 23 BT

10" Fir bears S 47°E, 31 lks, mkd. 1/4 S 26 BT

Original stone not found, found SE BT now a 16" Fir-legible (note:- This BT is at pool elev. Has been girdled and painted so-it will die) NE BT blown down years ago-rotted but position of stump recovered together with clearly legible fragments of the old marking at position indicated by BTs.

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 8/10/66

We set a stone 36"x4"x4" in a large mound of stone. Mkd. it with X on top and 1/4 on N face.

We tagged original SE BT with Std. BT. sign.

Point is at lower edge of large sliderock at top of 18' ledge

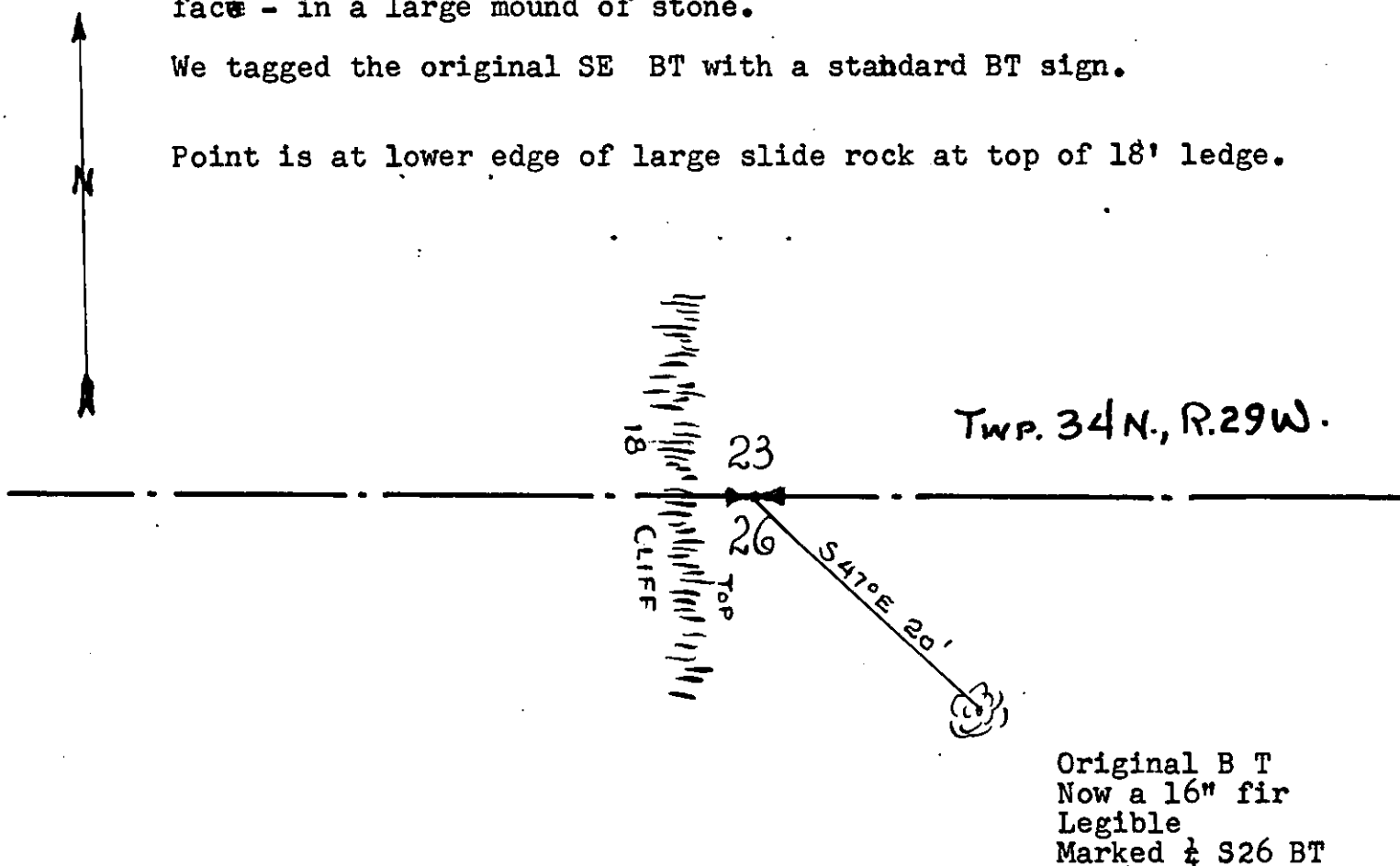

Since the point for this corner falls slightly below pool elevation we considered it unnecessary to perpetuate the point with a standard brass capped monument - HOWEVER - at the position indicated by the BTs we set a stone 36" x 4" x 4" marked with an X on top and  $\frac{1}{2}$  on the north face - in a large mound of stone.

We tagged the original SE BT with a standard BT sign.

Point is at lower edge of large slide rock at top of 18' ledge.



Note: This Bearing Tree has been girdled and painted with yellow paint - so it will die soon.
