 Desc. Granite stone in place, 20x16"x10" above grd mkd W/cross(X)  
 and 1/4 on N. face. 10" Lodgepole bears N36 1/2° E, 54 lks, mkd. 1/4 S 15 BT  
 20" Fir bears S 35 1/2° E, 55 lks. mkd 1/4 S 22 BT

Oxt. 13, 1966  
 Found the original stone which is not a 20"x16"x10", stone in place  
 above ground but is 12"x12"x5" stone lying flat with X and 1/4 on top-  
 the stone is at the reported bearing and distance from the NE BT  
 which is now 10"-live, markings plain-The SE BT is gone (blowdown) The  
 corner is on a steep slope to the E. in a small clearing (± 80' in Dia.)  
 Caused by windfalls. Approximately 1800 Ft. above the River

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 13/10/66

We set a Std. Brass Capped Mounment in a large mound of stone.  
 Original stone is base of mound. Cap mkd 1/4 <sup>15</sup>/<sub>22</sub>  
 1966

We tagged the original BT with a Std. Bt. sign.  
 We blazed and scribed a 6" Fir which bears S70°W 44' mkd. 1/4 S 22 BT  
 10 Ft. Lodgepole bears N36 1/2° E, 36' mkd. 1/4 S15 BT  
 6" Fir mkd. 1/4 S22 BT bears S70°W 44 ft. (light snow)

 Approximately 1800 feet above the river..

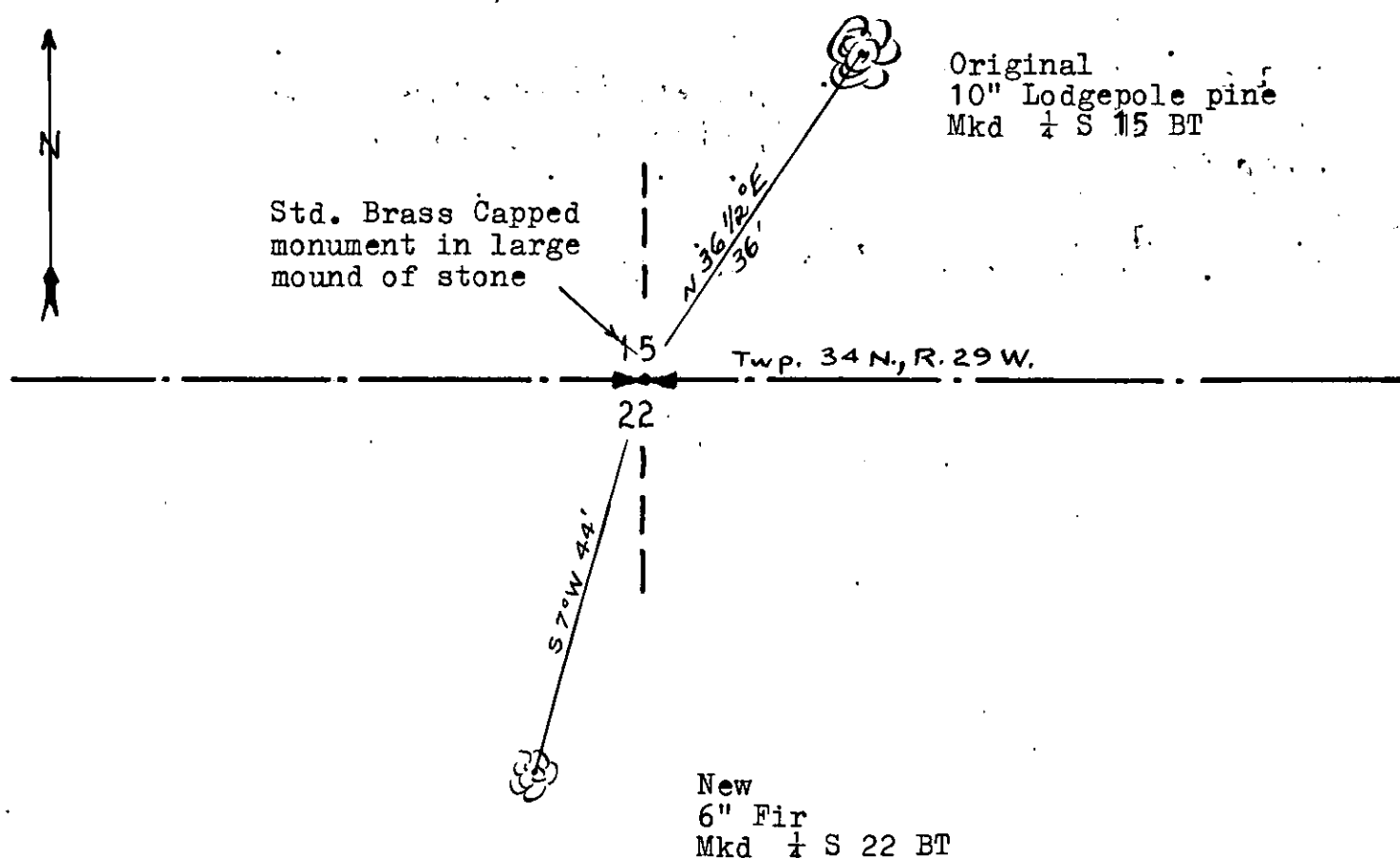
We set a standard brass capped monument in a large mound of stone, with
