We set a STD Brass capped monument in a mound of stone along side of the  
 original stone-from which a 5" Larch (original) Bears N 25°E 4 ft.-Mrkd as  
 reported. A 10" Pine Bears N 30°W 5½ Ft. (original marked as reported-  
 A 5" Larch (original) bears S 38° E 4'. (marks overgrown)  
 A 7" Larch Bears S20°W 1.5 (Marks overgrown)  
 We tagged NE, NW, and SW BTs with Std. BT signs.
