Failed to find original stone-since this corner is on a very steep slope near top of rock slide- stone probably rolled down hill.

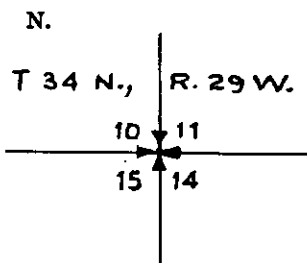
