## **BLM REMONUMENTATION 1964**

Found the original stone loosely set but clearly marked and witness by the original bearing trees.

Set a 2 1/2" X 30" iron post with a brass cap, 27 inches in the ground, marked as shown below, from which the 4 original bearing trees are as follows:


A 10" pine bears N38° 15'E, 13 links (record 15 links) A 6" pine bears S21° 15'E, 31 links (record 36 links) A 12" pine bears S47° 30'W, 20 links (record 22 links) A 10" pine bears N30° 15'W, 22 links (record 26 links)

Bury the original stone alongside the iron post.

## FOUND:

Found the BLM brass cap and bearing trees as noted in the 1964 monumentation.

I repainted the bearing trees and placed a 6 foot metal post with Land Survey Monument Decal 2 feet west of the corner.
