

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found original brass cap tipped over but in its original position (Determined by record bearing and distance) (Record-set a small stone, marked with a cross (x), under an iron post 2 ins. dia. 36 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked from which: - A 18 inch Fir, snag, scribing visible, bears S $33\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W-53 links. (Record- A 12 In. Dia. Fir, bears S $33^{\circ}30'$ W., 53 links distance, blazed and scribed 1 HES 739 BT.) a 20 inch Larch, alive, scribing visible, bears S $88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W-63 links. (Record - A 9 in. dia. Fir, bears S $88^{\circ}30'$ W., 63 links distant, blazed and scribed 1 HES 739 BT.)

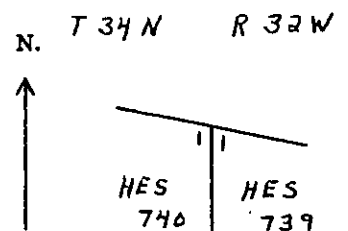
