A blazed hemlock tree, 12 ins. in diam., marked BT 10-5024, bears S.98 30'E., 20 ft. dist. A blazed cedar tree, 26 ins. in diam., marked 10-5024 BT, bears S.60 40'w., 13 ft. dist." 1917 HES original record by E. R. Johnson: "Cor. No. 10 of survey No. 5024 Evergreen Placer, identical in point for Cor. No. 5 of list 1-2594, which is a post 5 ins. square, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. As this post is badly rotten, I destroy it and in same place set for Cor. No. 5 of this survey and Cor. No. 10 of survey No. 5024, a small stone 28x8x8 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, marked 5 HES 844 on the NW. face; 10 MS 5024 on SE. face, and a cross (X) on top for exact corner point.
