1917 HES 735 record by Elmer R. Johnson: "Set for Cor. No. 4, a small stone marked with a cross(X) under a quartzite stone 26x8x5 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, marked 4 H.E.S. 735 on NW face and a cross (x) on top for exact corner point."

No bearing trees available, therefore dig pits $24 \mathrm{x} 24 \mathrm{x} 12$ ins. crosswise on this and the succeeding course, 7 ft. distance and raise a mound of earth 4ft. base, 2 ft. high, NW of corner.

1921 HES 1063 record by Grant Higgins: To Cor. No. 4 of HES No. 735 (patented) which is a quartzite stone, 10x6x5 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by by the Surveyor General. I adopt this Cor. for Cor. No. 2 of this survey, and mark it 2 HES 1063 on NE. face.

No bearing trees available, therefore dig a pit 24x24x12 ins. on line 2-1. Repair pit on line 2-3. Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high NE. of Cor.
