Corner 1/4 Sec. 25&26 T. 35N R. 27W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1913 G.L.O. Original Record by Royston C. Durnford et.al.: Set a limestone, 14x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. "1/4" on the West face.


Established two bearing trees:

A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears N19 1/4°E, 68 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S25 BT". A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N70°W, 31 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S26 BT".

II. Found a limestone, 8x6 ins., protruding 5 ins. above the ground, firmly set, mkd. "1/4" on the W. face. from which:

A rotten stump, bears N19°E, 44.9 ft. dist., with a healed face. A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears N70°W, 20.0 ft. dist., with a healed face.

III. At the corner position, of original stone, set a 30 ins. long x 2 1/2 ins. diam. aluminum pipe, 23 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, mkd. as shown. Buried the original found stone alongside the aluminum pipe.




Established one new bearing tree:
