
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner NW Sec. Cor. Sec. 13 T. 35N R. 27W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1913 G.L.O. Original Record by Lowellyn D. Lyman et.al.: Set a limestone, 12x12x4 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for cor. secs. 11, 12, 13 & 14, mkd. with 4 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the E. edge. Established four bearing trees.

1961 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by David R. Cunningham et.al.: The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 & 14, monumented with a limestone, 14x10x4 ins., loosely set, and mkd. with 1 notch on the E. and 4 notches on the S. faces, and witnessed by the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with a brass cap mkd. as shown.



Established two new bearing trees and buried the original stone alongside the iron post.

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 4 ins. above the ground, frimly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. B.L.M. brass cap mkd. as shown above.

A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N59°E, 48.4 ft. dist., with visible marks. (GLO-record-N55°E)

A larch, 19 ins. diam., bears S75°E, 15.4 ft. dist., "13" visible.. (GLO-record-22 lks., 14.2 ft.)


A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S60°W, 28.7 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-rec.-S56°W, 28.3 ft.)

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N27°W, 57.1 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record-N31°W)

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N62°W, 36.5 ft. dist., with a healed face. (GLO-record-N68°W)

III. Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
