
Corner 1/4 Sec. 24&25 T. 35N R. 27W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1913 G.L.O. Original Record by Royston C. Durnford et.al.: Set a limestone, 12x10x8 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. "1/4" on the N. face.

Established two bearing trees:

A larch, 10 ins. diam., bears N31°E, 4 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S24 BT". A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears S42°W, 43 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S25 BT".

1961 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by David R. Cunningham et.al.: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 24 & 25, monumented with a limestone, 12x10x8 ins., firmly set, and mkd. "1/4" on the N. face, and witnessed by the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with a brass cap mkd. as shown.



Established two new bearing trees and buried the original stone alongside the iron post.

II. Found a B.L.M. brass cap, protruding 2 ins. above the ground, frimly set, mkd. as shown above.

A larch, 17 ins. diam., bears N53°E, 3.3 ft. dist., with a healed face. (GLO-rec.-N31°E,2.64 ft.)

A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears S30°E, 64.4 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record)


A rotten stump, bears S47°W, 26.3 ft. dist., with visible scribe. (GLO-rec.-S42°W, 28.38 ft.)

A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears N71°W, 38.9 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record)

III. Built up a collar of stone around the monument.

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
