

1894 G.L.O. original record by Abram L. Jaqueth: Set a wooden post with two bearing trees.

1915 H.E.S. original record by Elmer R. Johnson: Establish two bearing trees and a mound of earth.

1959 BLM remonumentation by David R. Cunningham: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, identical with cor. No. 1 of Homestead Entry Survey No. 332, monumented with the decayed remains of the original wooden post and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with brass cap mkd.

The original H.E.S. bearing tree:

A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears S47 1/4 E, 51 lks. dist., mkd. 1 HES 332. (Record) A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears N9 1/2 W, 52 lks. dist., mkd. 1 HES 332. (Record N11 29'W, 51 lks.)

The new bearing trees:

A larch, 10 ins. diam., bears N79 $^{\circ}$ E, 44 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S18 BT. A larch, 10 ins. diam., bears S74  $1/4^{\circ}$ W, 45 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S13 BT.

Bury the remains of the original wooden post and set a wooden post, 4 ins. square, 5 ft. long, alongside the iron post."

II. Found a 2 1/2 ins. diam. pipe, 3 ins. out of the ground, with BLM brass cap mkd. as shown (Dated: 1961) from which

A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears N79 E, 29.5 ft. (45 lks.) dist., no visible scribing. A larch, 16 ins. diam., bears 847 E, 34.1 ft. (52 lks.) dist., visible scribing. A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears 877 1/4 W, 29.7 ft. (45 lks.) dist., no visible scribing. A larch, 15 ins. diam., bears N11 W. 34.3 ft. (52 lks.) dist., no visible scribing.

III. Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, South, 3 ft.
