ORIGINAL RECORD: A lime stone 12x10x8", 8" in the ground, with 1/4 marked on West face, from which:

- A 6" balsam bears S.73 1/2°E., 9.90 feet
- A 4" balsam bears N.71 1/2°W., 19.14 feet

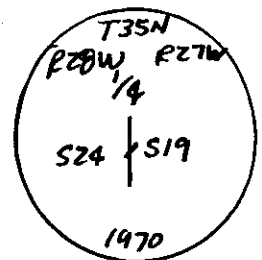

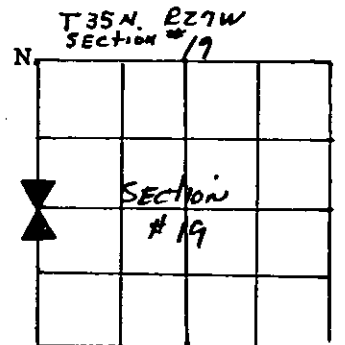
