40.00 Set a slate stone 14x9x6 ins. 9 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; from which A fir, 6 ins. dia., bears S. $10\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 4 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T A tamarack 18 ins. dia., bears N. $60^{\circ} 45'$ W. 52 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 B T

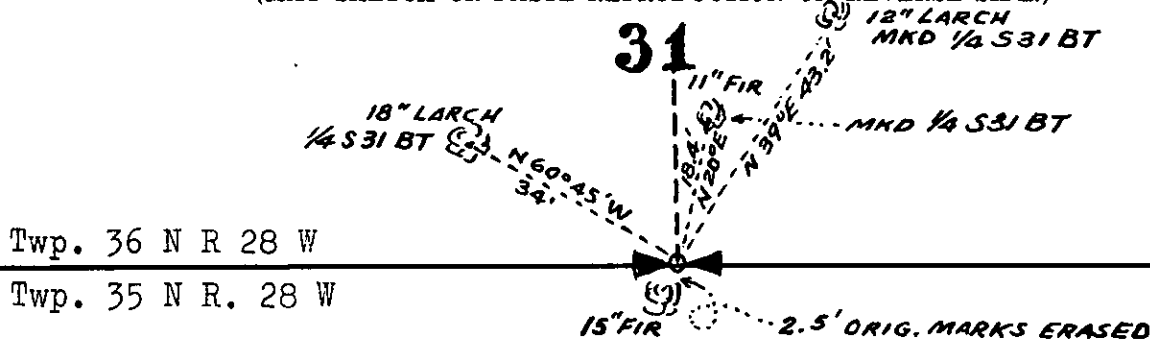

35.95 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, which is a limestone 6x6x6 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
This corner will hereafter refer to sec. 31 only, therefore, I erase the marks referring to sec. 6 from SW. bearing tree, and mark a new one as follows:- A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. $22\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 28 lks, dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T. FOR EVIDENCE FOUND SEE REVERSE SIDE

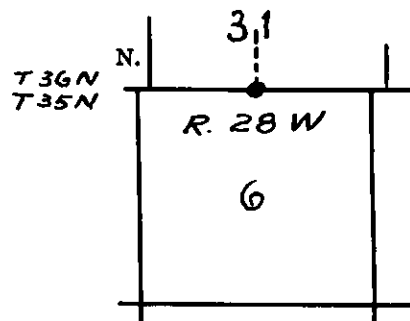
