

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner Cor. 4 H.E.S. 457 Sec. 6 T. 35N R. 31W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1915 G. L. O. original notes by Fred E. Thieme: Set for Cor. No. 4, a small stone, marked with a cross "X" under a quartzite stone, 26 X 16 X 8 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, marked 4 HES 457 on NE. face, and a cross "X" on top for the exact corner point, from which:

A cross "X" on a lodgepole pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S 10°13' W, 22 lks. dist.  
A cross "X" on a lodgepole pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S 63°00' W, 11 lks. dist., each blazed and scribed 4 HES 457 BT.

Raise a mound of earth and stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, NE. of corner.

II. Found a stone, 5 X 12 ins., 10 ins. above the ground, firmly set and mkd. 4 HES 457 on NE face, and a cross "X" on top, mound of earth and stone NE of the corner, from which:

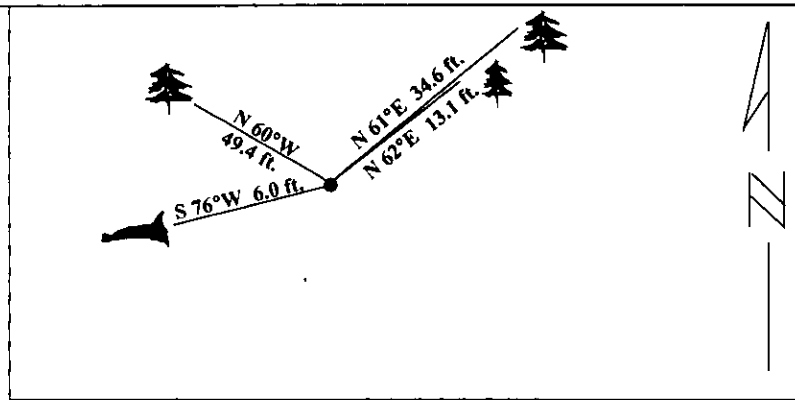
A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N 62°E, 13.1 ft. (19.8 lks.), mkd. with visible ax marks.  
A dead pine, 11 ins. diam., bears S 76°W, 6.0 ft. (9.1 lks.), mkd. 4 HES 457 BT.

III. Establish two new bearing trees:

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears N 61°E, 34.6 ft. dist., mkd. 4 HES 457 BT.  
A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N 60°W, 25.7 ft. dist., mkd. 4 HES 457 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East
