
INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Record: A wooden post 12 X 5 X 5 inches above the ground, I mark this post for corner No. 1, 1 HES 450 on SW face. from a nail in top a cross (X) on a lodgepole Pine tree, 4 inches diameter, bears N11 33'W., 139 links distance. A cross (X) on a Lodgepole Pine tree, 4 inches diameter, bears N85 45'W., 128 links distance; each blazed and scribed 1 HES 450 BT.
- 2. Found: A stone 6" X 8" X 8" with a scribed (X) on top no BTs or stone mounds.
- 3. Set: after verifying the location of this stone to be correct. A 14" Larch bears S 42° W 44.8 feet scribed corner 1 HES 450 BT posted.
