DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found a 2 1/2" B.L.M. brass cap appr. 4" above ground. Mound of stone appr. 2.0 ft. W.
Marked as shown:

From which: A 9" douglas fir bears N65°E, 48.0 ft. Healed face, alive and well.
A 14" larch bears S37°W., 26.7 ft. Scribing visible, alive and well.

1960 B.L.M. record, from found original evidence : Set a 2 1/2" iron pipe with brass cap.

From which: A larch stump 16" diam., bears S35°W., 40 lks.
A 6" fir bears N66 3/4°E., 73 lks.



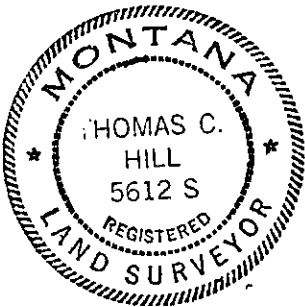

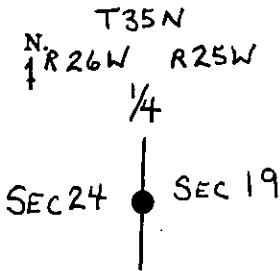
