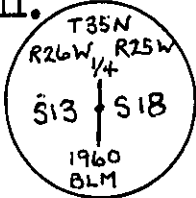


CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

1960 B.L.M. record, from found original evidence: Set a 2 1/2" iron pipe with brass cap.
Marked as shown:
From which: A 6" fir bears S50 3/4° E., 66 lks.
A 7" fir bears N47 1/4° W., 49 lks.

Found a 2 1/2" B.L.M. brass cap appr. 3" above ground. Mound of stone appr. 2.0 ft. W.
Marked as shown:
From which: A 10" douglas fir bears N50° W., 32.4 ft., healed face, alive and well.
A 14" larch stump bears S50° E., 15.1 ft.

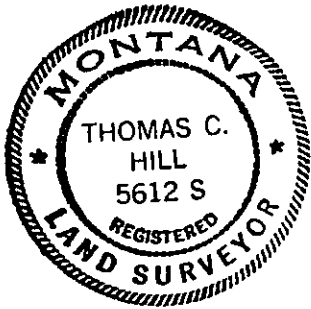


DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED

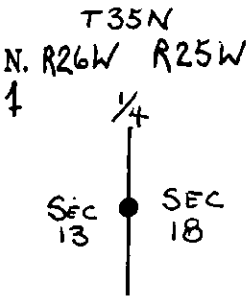
