

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

26W P.M., MT 35N Lincoln County Corner 32&33

1894 G.L.O. Original Record by Frank L. Sizer et. al.: Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in I. the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. mkd. "1/4 S" on W. face. Established two bearing trees.

1959 Remonumentation Record by David R. Cunningham et. al.: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, as determined from the remains of the wooden post and witnessed by the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 in. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with brass cap mkd. as shown.





Established two new bearing trees and buried the remains of the wooden post alongside the iron post.

Found a B.L.M. brass cap, protruding 6 ins. above the ground, firmly set, mkd. as shown above. II.

from which:

A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears N74°E, 26.1 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record-39 lks., 25.7

A rotten larch stump, bears S68°E, 17.8 ft. dist., "BT" visible. (GLO-record)

A rotten stump, bears N50°W, 3.3 ft. dist., no visible marks. (GLO-record)


A fir stump, 12 ins. diam., bears N70°W, 15.2 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record)

III. Established one new bearing tree:

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S25°W, 17.2 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S32 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
