

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)
1/4 CORNER COMMON TO SECTION 10 & 11, T.35N., R.26W., P.M.M.
LINCOLN COUNTY, MONTANA

Found brass cap set in concrete with bearing trees. Record-Set iron post, 30" long, 2 1/2" diam., 26" in the ground, in concrete with brass cap marked, 1/4 S.10, S.11, T.35N., R.26W. from which the remains of the original bearing trees. A fir, stump, 10" diam., bears S.16 1/2° E., 40 links distance, visible marks S. BT. (Record)

The New Bearing trees;
A fir, 7" diam., Bears S.11 3/4° E., 52 links distance marked 1/4 S.11 BT A fir, 7" diam., Bears S.54 1/4 W. 14 links distance, marked 1/4 S.10 BT Bury stone alongside.


