A fir 14 inches diam. bears N.30°W., 29 links (19.14 ft.) dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. BT.

FOUND:

No evidence of original Sizer survey found on ground.

A 2 inch diam. galvanized iron pipe with no cap set by 2989-ES per corner recordation form No. 1145.

MAINTENANCE:

From the accepted position of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner by 2989-ES we established two BT's described as follows:

A $12\frac{1}{2}$ inch diam. Douglas fir bears N.54°30'W., 7.3 feet scribed "½ S. 28 BT"

A 7 inch diam. Douglas fir bears N.53°30'E., 9.6 feet scribed "1/4 S. 27 BT."

Placed BT signs and painted the blazes red.

Painted a 6 inch band around the trees above the BT signs.
