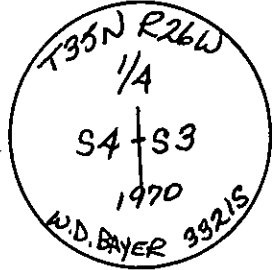
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found a 2½" iron pipe approximately 3" above ground with brass cap marked as shown.  
Collar of stone.

From which: A 9" lodgepole pine bears N 29°W, 8.8 ft., scribing visible  
1970 Record: Monument as above and stamped as shown.

From which: A 10" lodgepole pine bears N 32°W, 9.0 ft.  
A 6" lodgepole pine bears S 7°W, 16.5'

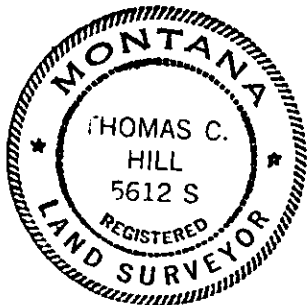

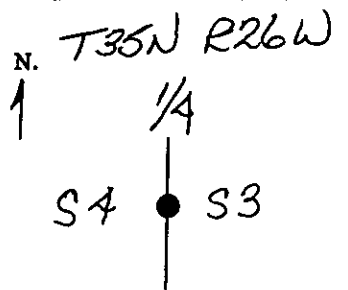
