
Corner 1/4 Sec. 28 & 29 T. 35N R. 26W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. <u>1894 G.L.O. Original record by Abram L. Jaqueth:</u> Set a wooden post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., mkd. 1/4 S. on the W. face.

From which:

A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears S72° 45'E, 36 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S BT". A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears S3° 15'W, 33 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S BT".

1973 CCR by Dean K. Marquardt, filed at Lincoln County Courthouse, Book #1, page #1137: Found two original B.T. stumps with scribing still visible. Found evidence of original post. Set a brass cap mkd. as shown below:



Established two new bearing trees:

A tree with "ES Tag", bears S59°E, 22.7 ft. dist... A tree with "ES Tag", bears S10°W, 28.2 ft. dist...

II. Found a 2 in. diam. brass cap, firmly set, flush with ground, with cap mkd. as shown above.

From which:

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S32°E, 15.6 ft. dist., with "ES Tag".

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears West, 9.1 ft. dist., with "ES Tag".

(The bearing trees were not scribed, and neither matches Marquardt record.)

A 6 ft. tall, 6.5 in. x 9 in. square, wooden post, bears East, 1.5 ft. from monument.


No evidence of orig. bearing trees found.

III. Scribed and painted existing bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S32°E, 15.6 ft. dist., scribed "1/4 S28 BT".

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears West, 9.1 ft. dist., scribed "1/4 S29 BT".

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
