## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**


Corner North MC Secs. 17&18 T. 35N R. 26W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. <u>1894 G.L.O. Original record by Abram L. Jaqueth:</u> Set a quartzite stone, 12x12x8 ins., 8 ins. the ground, for meander cor. to frac. secs. 17 & 18, mkd. "MC" on the S. face.

From which:

A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears N39°E, 68 lks. dist., mkd. "T35N R26W S17 MC BT". A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N74°15'W, 68 lks. dist., mkd. "T35N R26W S18 MC BT".

1959 B.L.M. record by David R. Cunningham: The meander cor. of secs. 17 and 18, on the N. shore of Frank's Lake, determined at record bearing and dist. from the orig. N.E. bearing tree, which is a snag. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S62 3/4°E, 5 lks. dist., mkd. "T35N R26W S17 MC BT". A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N13°W, 14 lks. dist., mkd. "T35N R26W S18 MC BT".

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of the iron post.

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam., iron post, firmly set, protruding 5 ins. above the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. BLM brass cap mkd. as shown above.

From which:

A stump with downed log alongside, bears S62°E, 3.3 ft. (5 lks.) dist., mkd. with visible scribe. A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N13°W, 9.9 ft. (15 lks.) dist., mkd. with a healed face.

No evidence of orig. bearing trees found.


A steel guard post, bears East, 1.0 ft. dist., with LSM decal.

III. Established one new bearing tree:

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N58°W, 10.2 ft. dist., mkd. "MC S18 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
