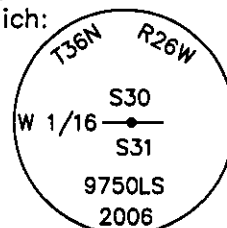

 Record: 1893 Subdivision and Meanders of Fractional T36N, R26W, by Peter M. Cardell and

- I. Abraham L. Jaqueth
1933 U. S. Forest Service Exchange Survey No. 1252 by A. O. Modlin: Set temporary stake at true proportionate point for the W. 1/16 sec. cor.
1970 Plat No. 1711 by Jack H. Ninneman, Mt. Reg. No 534ES: Sets a "Lifetime" survey marker and 2 bearing trees:
 "16" pine bears East 10.0 feet and a 12" larch bears N11°30'E, 22.3 feet. Both marked BT 16 W and posted".
2004 Certificate of Survey No. 3299 by Dawn Marquardt, Mt. Reg. No. 7328S: Establishes the NW cor. for Parcel A which appears to also be the W 1/16 for Secs. 30 and 31. Cites found Ninneman rebar N87°49'12"W, 14.29'.

- II. Found Ninnemans 2" diam. plastic cap from which:

A larch, 11 ins. diam, bears N11°E, 22.3 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face.
 A down pine, 16 ins. diam, bears N80°E, 10.0 ft. dist., mkd. BT 1/16 W.
 A 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked 7328S, bears S82°52'52"E, 14.25'.

- III. Set by survey a 2 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long aluminum pipe, 26 ins. in the ground, with 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap in a collar of stone, marked as shown, from which:



A 5/8 in. diam. rebar with a 1 1/4 in. diam. yellow plastic cap marked MARQUARDT 7328S, bears N87°48'49"E, 5.85 ft. dist.
 A 2 in. diam. plastic cap, bears N84°53'46"W, 8.43 ft. dist. Cap is not marked.
 A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears N10°W, 23.0 ft. dist., marked with a healed face.
 (Ninneman BT)

Establish 1 new bearing tree:

A fir 6 ins. diam., bears S45°W, 38.9 ft. dist., marked W 1/16 S31 BT.

Attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs to the bearing trees. Painted red the scribed face and a red band around the bearing trees. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Property Boundary and Land Survey Monument decals attached, North, 3 feet.

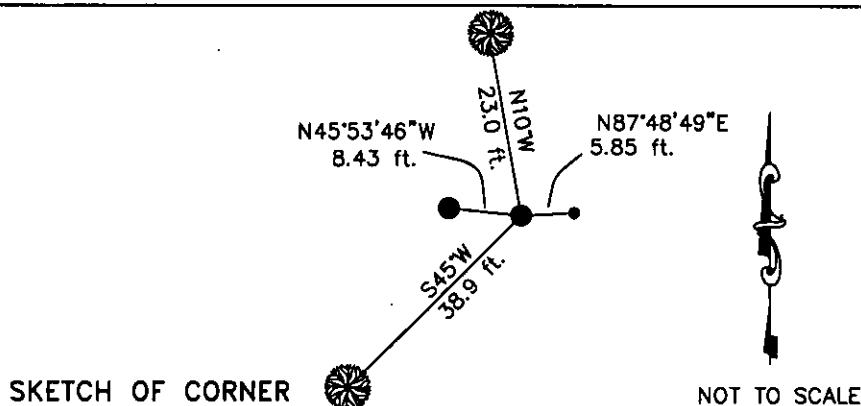

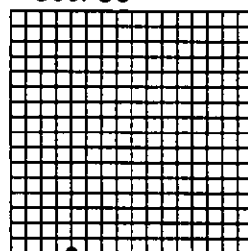
