

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

GLO Record: Set post, from which: A 14° fir bears N 18° E 47 lks.
A 16" Fir bears S 63° W 43 lks.

BLM Record (1959 Remonumentation): Found disintegrated wood post, and the remains of the original bearing trees. Set a Brass Cap, from which:
the remains of the original bearing trees:
A 23" stump bears N 18° E 47 lks., visible marks B.T.
A 26" stump bears S 63° W 43 lks., marked 1/4 S B.T.
the new bearing trees:
A 9" Fir bears N 75 1/4° E 36 lks.
A 6" Pine bears S 33 1/4° W 30 lks.

Date of work: Nov. 1975

Found: BLM Brass Cap with old rotted post lying alongside, from which:
A stump bears N 17° E 30.65'
A rotted stump bears S 63° W 29.8'
A BLM bearing tree stump bears N 75° E 36 lks.

Set two new bearing trees: A 3" Fir bears N 45° W 3.51'
A 6" Fir bears N 28° E 18.48'

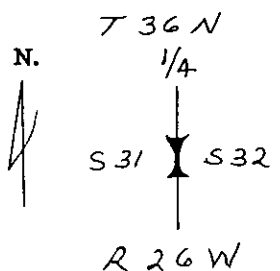
