

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Record: Set red sandstone 14 x 12 x 10 10" in the ground, marked 1/4 on West from which:

A 5" Fir bears S 27°E 28 lks.
A 10" Fir bears S 80° W 67 lks.

Found: Sandstone still firmly in place and properly marked.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: **July, 1975**

Since the stone is still firmly set, we did not remonument it. We set two new bearing trees as follows:

A 12" Ponderosa Pine bears N12°W 29.37'
A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears S 29°W 9.24'

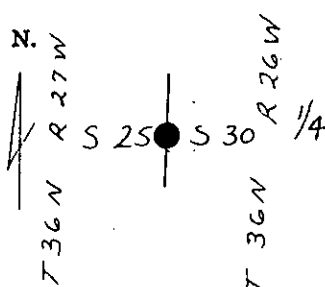
