

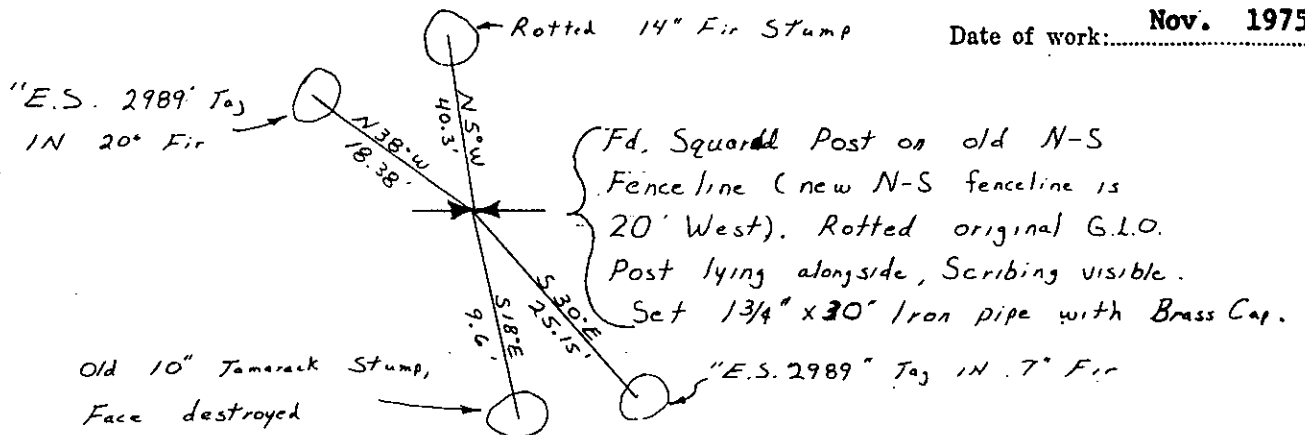
# CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

## DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

G.L.O. Record: Set a Post marked "1/4S" on North face from which:  
 A 14" Fir bears N 1°15' W 59 links  
 A 9" Tamarack bears S 34°30' E 15 links

Found: A squared post (not G.L.O.) on old fenceline, original G.L.O. post with scribing still visible lying on ground at base. An old Fir stump, badly rotted, bears N 5°W 40.3', an old Tamarack stump with destroyed face bears S 18° E 9.6'. Set brass cap at base of post described above.
