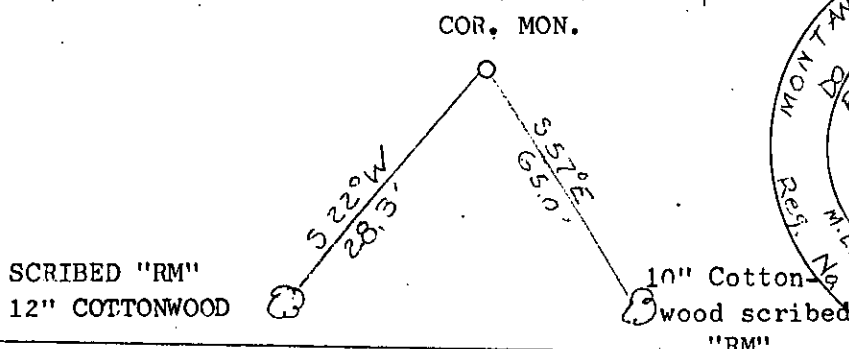
ORIGINAL G.L.O. NOTES: "Set a limestone, 16 X 12 X 6 ins. 11 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 13, 18, 19 & 24 marked with 3 notches on N. and ~~notches on S. edges.~~ dug pits 18X18X12 ins. in each Sec. 5 1-2ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2ft. high, 4 1-2 ft. base alongside."

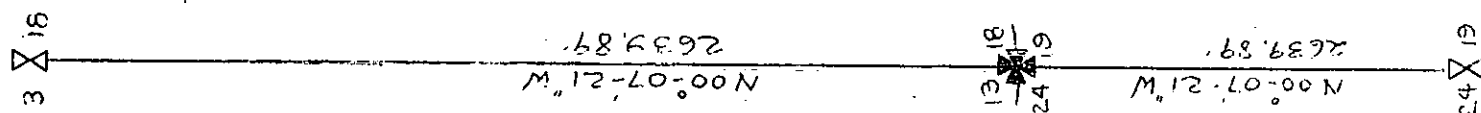
