


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

- III. Set by survey, an aluminum rod, 30 ins. long, 3/4 in. diam., 8 ins. below the road surface, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown below:




Established two bearing trees:

- A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears N09°E, 44.6 ft. dist., mkd. "CE 1/16 S27 BT".
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N74°E, 74.2 ft. dist., mkd. "CE 1/16 S27 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
Corner falls in the middle of road no. 3668.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
