
## CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 1/4 26&27 36N R. P.M., MT Sec. Lincoln County

1893 G.L.O. Original Record by Peter McCardell et. al.: Set a limestone, 20X8X6 ins., 15 ins. in I. the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. mkd. "1/4" on the W. face. Established two bearing trees.

1959-60 B.L.M. Remonumentaton Record by David R. Cunningham et. al.: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 27, monumented with a limestone, 12x6x4 ins., firmly set, mkd. as described in the original record and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees. At the corner position, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, in concrete, with the brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S53 1/2°E, 99 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S26 BT".

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N34°W, 68 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S27 BT".

Bury the original stone alongside and raise a mound of stone, 3.0 ft. base, 2.0 ft. high, W. of the iron


II. Found a 3 1/4 in. diam. BLM brass cap, firmly set, protruding 1 in. above the ground, and mkd. as shown above. A mound of stone, 3.0 ft. diam., West from the corner.

from which:

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S53°E, 65.3 ft. dist., with a healed face.. (BLM-record) A stump, 13 ins. diam., bears S56°E, 26.4 ft. dist., no visible scribe. (GLO-record) A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N34°W, 44.9 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record) A rotten stump, bears N65°W, 71.3 ft. dist., no visible scribe. (GLO-record)


